

Community Group Questions 10.6.19

This should be your second meeting! Make sure that as you think through your evening, think about all those who will be coming. Some might be new to the group, some might have been in your group for a while now. Start with conversations that would be welcoming to those who are newer.

Questions you might choose to discuss.

1. What impacted you most from Sunday? (This could include the preaching, the music, a conversation that you had with someone....)
2. When talking about the church and our involvement, why is it so important to start with the “why” questions? Why does church exist? Why is my participation necessary?
3. On Sunday we talked about the key to being an Acts 2 church. The key being what Peter describes in 1 Peter 1:22-25 - a view of each other in light of our eternal common salvation.
 - a. How do we practice seeing others the way that God sees us and not through our own eyes of seeing “human glory?”
 - b. This week who are some people that you need to start seeing differently? How can you do that?
 - c. Do you need help seeing yourself the way that God sees you?
 - d. Do you struggle seeing yourself only through the lens of personal glory? If so how can you have a better, more accurate picture of yourself?
