

COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS FOR JOSHUA

- 1) What makes a leader worth following?
- 2) Thinking back on what Joshua experienced in the accounts found in Numbers and Deuteronomy, how had God been preparing Joshua to become a leader?
- 3) Read Joshua 1:1-9 as a group. How does God's commissioning set the tone for what is to come in Joshua's life? Describe what you believe God would say to you today if He was commissioning you.
- 4) The events in Joshua happen as a result of God being faithful to honor His covenant to Israel and to give them the promised land. What does that gift have to say about the nature and character of God? What is God teaching us about His covenants?
- 5) Read Joshua 8:30-35 together. Why was this moment so significant to the people of Israel? What is being communicated about the power of God's Word when it's read together in community?
- 6) At the end of Joshua's life, he gives some final challenges to the people of Israel (see 23:1-24:15). It culminates with a final exchange between Joshua and Israel found in 24:14-28. What stands out to you in Joshua's last recorded words? Why?
- 7) Godly leaders call out people around them to serve and obey the Lord. Choose one person in your group or circle of influence that you can speak into and have an intentional conversation with them this week.
