COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS FOR LEVITICUS

- 1) What current traffic law irritates you the most and why?
- 2) Leviticus provides a host of specific requirements for holiness and worship. After reading through them, what's your sense of what God is communicating to His people through these laws?
- 3) In chapter 16, the most holy day in the Jewish calendar, the Day of Atonement was established. Why was it so important? (see verse 30)
- 4) Read Hebrews 9:11-14. How does the Day of Atonement point to this truth about the work of Jesus Christ? How does this Day begin to reveal God's great salvation story?
- 5) Leviticus 19:2 states a huge expectation and seems to raise the bar for behavior impossibly high. Why do you think God sets this expectation for His people?
- 6) Can you live an entire day being holy? How?
- 7) In Ephesians 1:3-4 we learn that holiness has been God's plan for us before the world was formed. It's clear we can't pull that off without the grace of Jesus and the partnership of others. Give a call to someone in your Community Group this week and check in on them and their holiness this week. Remind them of the freeing truth that this is God's perfect and good plan for them.
