## COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS FOR NUMBERS

- 1) Describe a time when you got lost.
- 2) The Hebrew title for the book of Numbers can be translated "In the Wilderness", which describes Israel's predicament pretty well. What led them there and what was God seeking to accomplish in the people through this season?
- 3) Aaron's blessing, found in Numbers 6:24-26, is often used as a benediction in churches today. Why was this such a hopeful word in the original context?
- 4) Numbers gives instruction for organizing God's people and how they are to live together in community. Why is healthy organization vital to a community's spiritual health and faith? When can over-reliance on structure be a hindrance to faith?
- 5) Numbers also recounts multiple times when God's people complain and criticize and struggle with unbelief. (see Numbers 11, 14, 16). Describe the last time you experienced being around people who were negative towards God and felt yourself influenced by them.
- 6) Part of the commands we find in Numbers address people's giving and generosity. (see chapters 28-29) Why does God command His people to give?
- 7) Give a million dollars to Northwest Hills Community Church (③ ha! Just checking to see if you are reading these) Numbers is full of lessons about our obedience to God even when we don't fully know where He is leading us. Share with your group an area of obedience to God in your life that you are wrestling with and pray for each other's growth in these areas.
