

## COMMUNITY GROUP QUESTIONS FOR TITUS

### WARM UP

What is the thing you find yourself hoping for most these days?

What got your attention in the message this week?

### EXPLORATION

1. In a similar way in which the character of leaders is addressed in 1 Timothy 3, Paul gives Titus instructions for overseers in Titus 1:8-9. What are the specific requirements given and why do you think he focused on these qualities?
2. Paul has some strong things to say in 1:10-18 and 3:9-10 about teachers in the church who were taking things sideways. Why was Paul so adamantly against them and what was the danger in their being given a place of influence in the church?
3. Titus 2:1-10 speaks to 5 different types of people. Who are they and what are they to model? Why is it important that their character and behavior is like this?
4. In Titus 2:11-14 we are told that God brought salvation to us to work real change in us. What is this change?

## APPLICATION

Titus 3:3-7 is an amazing statement about the way God has treated us with grace. Take time in your groups to pray out your thanks for what you see in these verses.
