## Questions for Hebrews 1, 2, & 3

## Warm Up

- 1. What common noises bug you the most?
- 2. In the message, Josh observed that it's not that God has a hard time speaking, it's that we have a hard time listening. What makes listening to God difficult?

## **Explore**

- 3. Read Hebrews 1:1. What is the point being made? Why do you think the book starts with this premise?
- 4. Read Hebrews 1:2-4. How does God speak now? Why do you think the author of Hebrews describes Jesus in the way we find in these verses?
- 5. Hebrews 2:1 warns us to pay careful attention to what we have heard from God? What are presently the things that keep you from paying careful attention to Him?
- 6. Hebrews 3:15 contains a warning about hardening our hearts to God's voice. That's especially challenging when there are so many other appealing voices out there competing for our attention. When you hear things from God that are uncomfortable or upsetting or convicting, how do you usually respond?
