- 3) Read the beginning of Deborah's song in Judges 5:1-5. What is the song saying about the Lord? What is this beginning of the song telling us about Deborah's perspective on the events of Judges 4?
- 4) Read Judges 5:6-8. What were the consequences to Israel in doing their own thing apart from God?
- 5) Read verses 9-11. Why is remembering the Lords' actions so important for us? How did this song help the people get perspective on His work with them?
- 6) Finish reading the song. Why did some of Israel not help in this time of crisis? Why do you think it was always so hard for Israel to be unified?
