Warm up

- 1) If God is still in the business of healing people, why would He do it? What do you think motivates Him?

Explore

- 2) Read Luke 4:38-41 and Matthew 8:14-17. What kind of effect do you think this event had on Peter?
- 3) In the message, Gary raised a series of questions that we can wrestle with when we consider the nature of God's miraculous activity of healing. Which question resonated with you and why?
- 4) Have you ever had God respond to a request you have made for healing by saying, "not yet?" How do you process that?
- 5) Read Luke 8:40-56. What is Jesus doing? How are people responding?
- 6) Jesus often connects the act of healing with faith. Why? How did the acts occurring in Luke 8:40-51 develop the faith of those in this account?

Apply

- 7) In your group, make a list of the times you have either witnessed first-hand, or directly heard about someone who had been healed. Now ask people in your group if anyone needs your group to pray for healing. Join together in asking the Lord to work His healing. Consider taking the counsel of James 5:14-16 to invite the elders to join in.
