

Questions for Peter's Walk #3

Warm up

- 1) Who is the biggest challenge or inspiration to your faith these days, and why?

Explore

- 2) Read Matthew 14:22-33. In this setting, what was causing the greatest fear in the disciples?
- 3) How did Jesus address the fear of the disciples? Why do you think He didn't immediately calm the storm?
- 4) What does Peter get right in this account? What leads to his doubt or small faith?
- 5) Share an experience from your life where you doubted the Lord. How was your faith affected?
- 6) What happens in the boat at the end of this story? (be as descriptive as possible)

Apply

In the message we were challenged to be like Peter and cry out to the Lord. For many of us, that's not the first thing we respond with, instead we trust in our own abilities or question whether the Lord really cares enough about us (though we'd probably not say that out loud). Spend some time in your group identifying what you need to cry out to Him for and then turn to Him in pray together. Include that final statement of worship from this story in your prayers.
